# **AMS Billing**

AMS fees are due no later than the first of each month. A \$25.00 late fee will be charged in the event the payment is not received by the fifth of the month. An additional \$5 per day fee will be assessed to all fee payments not received by the tenth. Communication is necessary with payment issues. Late fees will be strictly enforced.

#### Volunteer Work Vouchers

From time to time, AMS will have Volunteer Work Weekends. This is a time when the school opens on a Saturday morning for a few hours to allow parents and other volunteers to come in and perform tasks that aid in the upkeep of the school. Parents who participate for at least 4 hours are given a voucher for \$50 off one month's fees and may be remitted with the next installment.
